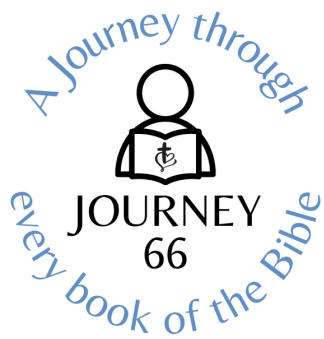

Today we continue our Journey through every book of the Bible with Rev. Dr. Jeff Wheeland. Our scripture today will be from Genesis 2.

Our featured international workers for today are M and C working in Central Asia. They are on a one-year home assignment and are spending time in our Central Valley connecting with personal supporters and friends until the beginning of June. They hope to develop new relationships to increase their support base. Let us pray for 10 new supporters giving \$100 a month and good connections with the existing supporters. M and C have served in Central Asia for eleven years where they worked for a community development non-governmental organization that works in the fields of health education, appropriate technology, and serving children with special needs. They most recently started a Doula program where women are formally trained as labor support coaches so they may provide guidance and physical support to the laboring mother and baby. M and C are returning to Central Asia in September to begin a new work in an unreached area. They will be starting a veterinary animal health training project that focuses on helping people better care for their animals which is their only source of income. They wish to thank you for your continued financial and prayer support.

- What was Adam's problem? How would you counsel someone that is struggling with loneliness? Any Bible passages you have found helpful? Please share.

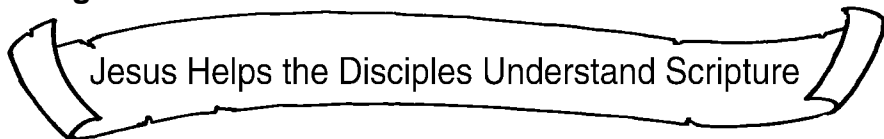
