Today we continue our Journey through every book of the Bible with Rev. Dr. Jeff Wheeland. Our scripture today will be from Genesis 2.

M and C are returning to Central Asia in September to begin a new work in an unreached area. They will be starting a veterinary animal health training project that focuses on helping people better care for their animals which is their only source of income. They wish to thank you for your continued financial and prayer support.




