BASIC TRUTH:

JESUS WANTS TO BE MY FRIEND FOREVER.

**DO THIS:****MORNING TIME**

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning, (name of child)! Time to wake up. It's a new day to look at all the things God made."

**DRIVE TIME**

As you drive, talk about what the different road signs and traffic signals mean. Say, "The road signs and traffic signals help us know what to do so we get where we're going safely. Jesus teaches us in the Bible how to make wise choices so we know what to do and can live our best life."

**CUDDLE TIME**

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to be our friend forever. I pray [child's name] will believe that Jesus is Your Son and choose to follow Him one day. Jesus really is the best friend we will ever have. Thank You for being so good to us, God. I love You. In Jesus' name, amen."

**BATH TIME**

Play "Peek-a-Boo" as you help your child bathe. Cover your eyes with a dry washcloth and say, "Jesus wants to be (uncover your eyes and say your child's name) friend forever!" Play again, only this time cover your child's eyes with a washcloth. Tell them to uncover their eyes when you say their name. Continue playing as long as your child is having fun.
