## OVERVIEW

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Why or how have we slipped into believing that God’s grace is “cheap grace” as Dietrich Bonhoeffer said.

2. Have you been one who has readily believed that calamities are the result of sin?

- If so, imagine you are in a context with Jesus like the disciples were in this text. Say that to Jesus. What do you hear Him say?
- Has the words of Jesus, in this text, changed your perspective? Discuss.

3. What role does repentance play in your life?

- Does it have a daily place in your life? Explain

4. Since Jesus said “repent or you will perish,” do you include repentance in your presentation of the gospel to unsaved people?

- If not, why?
