DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read 1 Peter 2:11-25. As you read, make note of anything that sticks out to you or makes you wonder. After reading, discuss those things.

- 1. Is there anyone in your life or have you ever been around someone in your life that makes you feel a sense of weight or who you think is so honorable? What about them did/does that?
- 2. Describe what it means to honor someone or something. Have you ever thought of it as an appraisal?
- 3. Jonathan said that "there is a direct correlation between your treatment of humanity and your honor of God because every human being is made in the image of God." Agree, disagree? Discuss.
- 4. Jonathan briefly walked through a typical day in his life with a recognition that every person is made in the image of God. Think through your typical day, what would change in your day if you had this frame of mind?
- 5. It is clear that many do not believe that humans are made in the image of God. How do you see this most apparently?
 6. Is it hard for you to "honor everyone?"
 Why or why not? How can we help each other with this?
- 7. Read 1 Peter 2:19-25. When you think of the command to "Honor Everyone" and look at the life of Christ, what comes to mind?

Devote time to prayer, even if that means you don't get to any questions.
