Read Psalm 96 - a Psalm for the world

- 1. Identify all the verses/lines that make it clear that this Psalm is for the world.
- 2. What does the psalmist want for the world? (ie. What does the psalmist want the world to do?) Why?

Read Matthew 28:18-20

- 1. Why did Jesus begin this sending commission the way He did? ("All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.")
- 2. What does it mean to "make disciples?" Have you done this? Are you doing it now? Why? Or Why not?
- 3. Jesus says the disciple making mission is for "all nations."
- How have you been a part of this mission for all nations? (Have you gone on missions trip? Pray? Financially support? Etc Etc.
- What can you do to have more of an international mission mindset? (ie. Have it as a part of your life)
- 4. What can your group do together in this international mission? (Regularly pray, partner with an international missionary? Support? Etc)
