OVERVIEW

The Story (pt. 1)

Everyone, whether they realize it or not, is living in a story. The scriptures tell one unified, unfolding story of the universe. Are you living in God's story, or another?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Did you know that scripture is telling one story? Can anyone share the story of scripture (short version)?
2. Jonathan said that "we all live and are guided by the stories that we believe are true and are worth being a part of." Do you agree with this? What are some stories you may have lived in before? What stories is the world selling?
3. Would you say you join the larger story of God or try to cram the story of God into your story? Discuss what this looks like in your life. What would it look like to merge your story into God's story?
4. Similar to the previous question, Donald Miller said that "A story is based on what people think is important, so when we live a story, we are telling people around us what we think is important." What would someone say is important to you?
5. Jonathan said that God is a talking God (primarily through His Word). How have you heard from Him recently? Where in His Word has he been speaking to you?

Devote time to praying for one another and around the discussion you had.

SCRIPTURE

Hebrews 1:1-4

Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.
