1. Can you remember when you went through a "test of your faith?" Are you in one now? Talk about it.

2. Why do you think people kept asking for more signs and miracles from Jesus, even though they had seen many? (John 6:30-31)

3. Doing the will of God is what brings pleasure to God, delight, joy, happiness. Do you ever think like this? Why? Why not?

4. Jesus said He came to do God's will. (John 6:38) Why was God "pleased to crush Him?" (Isaiah 53:10)

5. What was God's will in sending Jesus? (John 6:39-40) If that is still His will, what role do we have in telling others? Do you?

SCRIPTURE John 6:35-40

35 Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life: whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst. 36 But I said to you that you have seen me and yet do not believe. 37 All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out. 38 For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me. 39 And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day. **40** For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day."

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
