## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

"If faith is not just something you believe with your mind but also something that shapes the way you live, then it is important to consider what it means to live in light of the truth of the doctrine of creation. Living in light of this foundational truth is much more than rejecting evolution. This truth doesn't only require us to have a position on the origin of our world. 1. Have you ever thought in terms of the doctrine of creation "reaching into every dimension of your daily life?" Discuss.

2. What has your thinking of the doctrine of creation typically been? Simply that God created and therefore other theories are wrong?

Read Romans 1:18-23

1. Can you describe how God has "shown" a knowledge of Himself and made it "plain" to people?

2. Why do you think people "suppress" the truth? If they acknowledge the truth, then what?

3. How is God's "invisible attributes, namely His eternal power" and His "divine nature" seen in creation?

4. What does glorifying God look like for you, in your daily life? Do you think about it much?

5. Share the place worshipping God has in your daily life. Would you say it is a priority?

## SCRIPTURE:

Romans 1:18-23

**18** For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth. **19** For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. **20** For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world,[a] in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse. **21** For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened. **22** Claiming to be wise, they became fools, **23** and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things.
