OVERVIEW

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read Luke 12:49-59

1. Is it hard for you to read what Jesus said about Himself? (bringing fire, judgement, dividing families, etc) Why? Why Not?
2. Jesus said He was "greatly distressed."
 - Had you ever thought about Jesus' emotional state before?
 - When you hear how gripped with anguish Jesus' heart was, how does it make you feel or make you think?
3. Do you know someone or have you experienced a division in your family or friend group because of your faith in Jesus?
 - Will you describe it?
 - How did it feel for you? Worth it?
 - What would you say or how would you minister to someone who is in the middle of this now?

This would be a good time to talk about and pray for those in your life who are not saved and currently under the wrath and judgement of God.
