"For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago." – Ephesians 2:10 (NLT)

God-dreams are not limited by <u>age or gender.</u>

<u>I will pour out my Spirit upon all people. Your sons</u> and daughters will prophesy. Your old men will dream dreams, and your young men will see visions. – Joel 2:28 (NLT)

The dream is never about just you.

Never confuse a God-dream with personal ambition!
