"Third Sunday of Advent: Joy"

Luke 2:8-20 (NLT)

Joy is a gift of God.

"Don't be afraid!" he said. "I bring you good news that will bring great joy..." – Luke 2:10 (NLT)

It's not dependent on circumstances.

Around midnight, Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening.

- Acts 16:25 (NLT)

It's not dependent on possessions.

And the star...went ahead of them and stopped over the place where the child was. When they saw the star, they were filled with joy!

— Matthew 2:9-10 (NLT)

It's not dependent on popularity.

You will have a joy that no one can take away.

- John 16:22 (ERV)

You don't have to worry about who likes you when you know The One who LOVES you!

It's a joy that is offered to ALL of us!

I bring you good news that will bring great joy to <u>ALL</u> <u>PEOPLE.</u> – Luke 2:10 (NLT)

It's a joy offered to the worst of us.

It's a joy offered to the <u>least</u> of us.

It's a joy offered to the most <u>religious</u> of us.

It is a <u>life-changing</u> joy!

The shepherds went back to their flocks, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen. It was just as the angel had told them. – Luke 2:20 (NLT)
