5 Practical Ways to Walk in Your Calling with Love and Purpose

Objective: Help us as believers understand and live out our purpose according to God's will.

Key Verse: 1 Corinthians 13:1

1. Root Your Calling in Love

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 13:1-3, 1 John 47:7-12, Matthew 5:43-48

Your calling isn't about you, it's about loving and serving others.

Action Step:

 Identify one person who could benefit from your time, resources or encouragement and take intentional steps to express love towards them.

Question:

• Share a time you felt genuinely loved by someone's intentional actions.

2. Embrace Your Identity As Chosen

Scripture: Isaiah 43:1-2, Romans 8:28-30, 1 Peter 2:9-10

 You are specifically chosen and called by name, This anchors you in your faith to live out your purpose. Everything we do has a purpose, so don't waste it.

Action Step:

• Write a personal declaration of who you are in Christ based on scripture and read it out before you start your day.

3. Prioritize Wisdom and Discernment

Scripture: Proverbs 28:26, Psalm 1:1, James 1:5-6

• Your calling requires more than just information. It demands wisdom. The guidance we need comes only from God.

Action Step:

 Commit 5 to 10 minutes daily this week specifically asking God for wisdom and discernment for your current situation in your life.

Question:

What decision or challenge do you currently need God's wisdom to navigate?

4. Walk Consistently in Righteousness

Scripture: no scriptures given

- Righteousness is more than moral goodness. It's consistently aligning yourself with God's ways. With being consistent in this area, we position ourselves to receive divine protection, provision and peace, even amongst trials.
 - An example of consistently walking in righteousness is choosing honesty and integrity even when deception might provide temporary advantage.

Action Step:

 Identify one area in your life that is misaligned with God's word and take immediate action to correct it this week.

Question:

Why does righteousness matter in fulfilling our calling?

5. Respond to God's Call with Action

Scripture: Matthew 22:14, Philippians 3:12-14, 2 Timothy 1:6

- Knowing your calling is only the first step. Answering and actively living it out is crucial.
- Many know their calling, but don't live it out. Fully embrace your calling by taking intentional steps and trusting God along the way.

Action Step:

• Make a commitment this week (e.g. volunteering) or start having the conversations necessary to advance your calling (e.g. taking a spiritual gifts test).

Question:

What practical action can you take this week to respond more fully to your calling?
