Worship Inspired Scriptures

Colossians 3:16-17

- Open our mouths to give God praise and glory with thankful hearts.
- Whatever we do, we should be honoring Jesus which brings glory to God.

Ephesians 5:18-21

- Don't fill yourself with temporary pleasures, fill yourself with the Holy Spirit and sing praises to the Lord.

A big part of repenting and conversion is giving our lives over to God and praising him.

Scriptures

Romans 8:28-20

- God works for the good for those that love him and are called according to his purpose.
- God has plans for those he knew beforehand; He has called them.
- Jesus has made us justified, in right standing with the Lord. Jesus will glorify the justified.
 - Justified = righteous; acquitted; to be in right standing
 - **dikaioó: To justify, to declare righteous, to acquit**
 - **Original Word:** δικαιόω
 - **Part of Speech:** Verb
 - **Transliteration:** dikaioó
 - **Pronunciation:** dik-ah-yo'-o
 - **Phonetic Spelling:** (dik-ah-yo'-o)
 - **KJV:** free, justify(-ier), be righteous
 - **NASB:** justified, justify, freed, vindicated, justifies, acknowledged justice, acquitted
 - **Word Origin:** [from [G1342 \(δικαιος - righteous\)](#)]
 - 1. to render (i.e. show or regard as) just or innocent
- The Holy Spirit is a “down payment” or a foretaste to the coming glory that has been promised.

Titus 3:3-7

- At one point we were all in and of the world, giving into the lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes and giving into the pride of life.

- However, it was the love and the kindness of our savior that has saved us. It's not self righteousness that has justified us, it's God's mercy that has saved us.
 - Mercy = not getting what you do deserve
 - Grace = getting what we don't deserve
- God's mercy was sending Jesus to save us (mercy) so that we may receive justification (grace). We deserve death and punishment, but we get life, eternal life and blessings.
 - Justification only comes by his grace.

Galatians 3:23-25

- Before faith, the law was our guardian. As Jesus came, he has freed us from the custody of that guardian so that it is our **faith** in Jesus that will justify us.
 - Justification is by having faith in Jesus.

Galatians 2:16

- It is not by our works and the works of the law that justifies us. It's by our faith in Jesus that justifies us.

1 Corinthians 6:11

- We are justified in the name of Jesus Christ and by the Holy Spirit. Living a lifestyle of sin does not lead to justification. We have been washed (cleansed), sanctified (set apart) and justified (made to be in right standing) with God.

Romans 5:1-2

- We have peace with God through our justification through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- We now have grace to come to God through Jesus, boasting in the hope of the glory of God as Jesus returns to bring us into his Kingdom, allowing us to live in God's presence in our new glorified bodies.
 - Belief is knowing and faith is acting on your belief

* Romans 5:9-11

- We are justified by Jesus' blood. We are saved from God's wrath. If we were God's enemies and He still chose to save us by sending Jesus, how much more will we be saved now as we have been justified through Jesus? We have been reconciled with God.
