It's Time to Prosper, part 1

Scripture

3 John 1:2

- Are we living up to prospering in our homes and wherever we go? There will be peace and cooperation.

~ Healthy biblical prosperity ~

John 15:5-8

- If I'm not bearing forth fruit, I have to check to see if I am connected to the vine.
- When we bear much fruit, God is honored and glorified.

Hebrews 6:1-3

- Leave behind the childlike understanding and move towards adult understanding.
- Have an adult conversation with ourselves about our circumstances, heart posture, etc.

~ Inspect what's obvious to get out of being stuck and not prospering. ~

1 Corinthians 3:1-3, 6

- When there is division and arguing and unjust expectations, we are not spiritually mature.
- God is the one that causes us to prosper.

~ Biblical prosperity deals with association and application. ~

What and who we are around can be the reason why we are stuck and not prospering. We shouldn't be hanging around undelivered people.

Genesis 39:2-5

- My association is with God and He is with me. People should see the Lord is with you. Every mountain can be moved, it's not an obstacle blocking our path. The Lord is with me so will make everything I put my hands to flourish and succeed.
- When you are associated with God, you want to be around others that are associated with God; those that fear the Lord and know there are possibilities (positive/godly thinking).

Psalm 16:8

- I shall not be moved. The lord is at my right hand so I declare that I will not be moved.

Psalm 46:5

- I am not going to be moved. I have the almighty God with me. There is nothing that is impossible. ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE WITH HIM.

Psalm 62:6 (KJV)

- “He only *is* my rock and my salvation: *He is* my defence; I shall not be moved.”

Joshua 1:8

- What am I thinking about? Am I thinking of the goodness of God or things not working out, etc.
- Observe and do: opportunities to forgive, opportunities to love, opportunities to stand on faith... do it.

Psalm 35:27 (KJV)
