Scripture

Matthew 16:24-28 (AMPC)

- We have discipline in so many things, get discipline in righteousness.
- Deny yourself. Fear, irritation, pride, anger... it all deals with self. In order to pick up the cross and follow Christ, we must deny ourselves and cling to him.
- If we cling onto our temporal life, we will lose our eternal life. In his return, we will be rewarded for what we have done.
- Position yourself to be spoken to, to hear the voice of our creator (God). Repent and be okay with starting over. The Lord is coming, so we must be in position when He comes.

Isaiah 55:6-11 (AMPC)

- The Lord is near. Seek him while He still can be found.
- God's word will not return to him void. Remind yourself of what God said because that is what will be fulfilled.

Isaiah 48:17 (AMPC)

• Allow yourself to be led by the Lord in the direction you must go.

2 Chronicles 20:20 (AMPC)

Psalm 37:4-9 (AMPC)

Delight in the Lord (be flexible, pliable, fully surrendered to the Lord) and He will give you the
desires of your heart.
