Overcoming

Weekly Recap Monday

- Revelation 2:7 (AMP)
 - Understand what it means to overcome the world. And "believing" is more than simply thinking something is true.
 - And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires. [2 Peter 1:4]
- Revelation 2:11 (AMP)
 - Not only do we need to hear, but UNDERSTAND what the Spirit says. There is a second death we must be mindful of.
- Revelation 21:8 (NLT)
 - o These are characteristics of those who have not overcome the world.
 - Matthew 10:33: "But whoever denies me before men, I will also deny him before my Father who is in heaven."

Tuesday

- 1 John 5:4 (AMP)
 - Understand what it means to be born of God and what victory looks like.
- 1 John 3:9
 - Look at the characteristics of someone truly born again. They do not keep practicing sin.
 - Don't you realize that you become the slave of whatever you choose to obey? You can be a slave to sin, which leads to death, or you can choose to obey God, which leads to righteous living. [Romans 6:16]
- 1 Samuel 15:23
 - Rejection of the word can look different, it's not up to us to judge the sins of others.
- Luke 11:9-10 (AMP)
 - How consistent is your prayer life? What are you asking for? Are we crying out for insight? Wisdom? Understanding?

Wednesday

- Ephesians 4:1-2 (AMP)
 - Let's look at the characteristics of someone born of God. Are you trying to do this on

your own strength or in humility and dependence on the Holy Spirit?

- 1 Peter 1:6-7
 - Is your faith genuine? What do you do when under pressure? When you're uncomfortable? When you're disappointed?
- Revelation 3:5 (NKJV)
 - Here are one of the promises that help us escape the world's corruption.

Thursday

- Romans 8:35-37 (AMP)
 - Do we feel abandoned under turmoil? Do we feel God has left us when stumble? If so, do you understand what love is? Is this not a promise of promises?
- 2 Chronicles 20:15
 - Are you still fighting your own battles? Wrestling in flesh and blood? Do you seek & understand The Lord's guidance? Are you afraid when a situation looks unfavorable?
- Revelation 12:11 (KJV)
 - O How do each of these equip us to overcome?
- Matthew 12:13 (NLT)
 - We have a need for endurance. Do you ever ask for this in prayer?
- Rewards For the Overcomer
 - Revelation 2:7 Anyone with ears to hear must listen to the Spirit and understand what
 he is saying to the churches. To everyone who is victorious I will give fruit from the tree
 of life in the paradise of God.
 - Revelation 2:11 Anyone with ears to hear must listen to the Spirit and understand what he is saying to the churches. Whoever is victorious will not be harmed by the second death.
 - Revelation 2:17 Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who is victorious, <u>I will give some of the hidden manna</u>. <u>I will also</u> give that person a white stone with a new name written on it, known only to the one who receives it.
 - Revelation 2:26-28 To the one who is victorious and does my will to the end, I will give authority over the nations— 27 that one 'will rule them with an iron scepter and will dash them to pieces like pottery'—just as I have received authority from my Father. 28 I will also give that one the morning star.
 - Revelation 3:5 He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.
 - Revelation 3:12 All who are victorious will become pillars in the Temple of my God, and they will never have to leave it. And I will write on them the name of my God, and they will be citizens in the city of my God—the new Jerusalem that comes down from heaven from my God. And I will also write on them my new name.
 - Revelation 3:21 BSB To the one who overcomes, I will grant the right to sit with Me
 on My throne, just as I overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

Saturday

- 1. Know Who You Are: Born of God, Not Bound by Feelings
 - o Each morning, declare that, "I am born of God; love and victory live in me."

- 2. Let Love Lead: Conquer Evil with Good
 - o Identify one person who offended you recently. This week, bless them—pray for them, send encouragement, or choose silence instead of retaliation.
- 3. Stay the Course: Persevere When Faith Is Tested
 - Write down one current challenge and beside it a verse of victory. Read it aloud daily until faith replaces frustration.
- 4. Use Your Authority: Speak and Stand in Faith
 - Target Your Fear: Name the fear holding you back, find a verse that counters it, and speak it aloud daily.
- 5. Walk Together in Unity: We Overcome as One Body
 - Reach out to one believer who's been distant or discouraged. Pray with them, not about them. Restore connection this week.

Sunday

- 1 Corinthians 15:55-57 (NLT)
 - We have victory of sin and death.
- Romans 6:14 (NLT) and Psalm 119:34
 - Sin no longer has power in our lives. Trying to follow the law on our own strength is impossible. Focus on what Christ has done, grow in understanding of who He is, and who He wants us to be, and He'll empower us to walk in the ways He's called us.
