Scripture

Mark 5:2-5

- Man was possessed, being tormented. He was causing harm to himself.

John 4:7,16-18

- Samaritan woman at the well. Jesus spoke to her where she was (literally and , ashamed and isolating herself from the other Samaritan women.

Acts 9:3-6

- Saul was on orders to search for Christians and persecute the church. On the way, he was blinded by a light, thrown to the ground and had an encounter with Jesus. Jesus says he's Jesus, that he is persecuting him, and that he would go to town and wait for further instruction.

~ Transformation starts with Jesus and continues with the Holy Spirit. ~

Understanding the power that God has given us is important, so we can walk in the power that has been given to us.

2 Timothy 1:6-7

- We should be coming to Jesus, WE are supposed to be fanning into flames that gifts that God has given to us. No one can do it, it is our responsibility.
- God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity. He has given us the Holy Spirit which is a spirit of power, love, self-discipline and a sound mind.

Isaiah 11:1-5

- Delighting in the Lord, justice to the poor, a spirit of wisdom, understanding, knowledge, fear of the Lord, This is the same spirit that we have.

John 3:34 *Pray it over yourself

- Jesus is filled with the Holy Spirit with no limitations.
- We should pray that we continue to be filled with the Holy Spirit with no limits. So we can hear from him, know what he's saying and direct me to so we can pour into others.
 - John 3:30 God is becoming greater and greater inside of us as we get less and less

Matthew 7:28-29

- Jesus speaks with authority because He is speaking God's word as He is filled with the Holy Spirit.
- Prayer, spending time in God's word, worshiping and praising are all ways to build that relationship with God so that when you say "I say...", it's God who is backing up your words. You're speaking from his words.

Mark 1:21-22

- Jesus is speaking with authority, unlike the other religious leaders.
- Jesus speaks with authority, full of the Holy Spirit. He has authority, power and speak from the Holy Spirit leaving no choice but the spirit to flee.
- We have authority in Christ through the Holy Spirit. When we speak to things with power and might, we have the authority to make these things flee as well. Not by our own power but by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Don't become timid or afraid when that power is tested. This isn't the spirit that is within us.
- Spend more time with the Holy Spirit and in God's word if you aren't seeing these things leave your life.
