Scripture

Luke 22:31-34

- Satan is going to sift us like wheat. Don't wait until after that has happened.
- Stand against the enemy, if not just for you, for your families sake. Standing in the gap, interceding on behalf of those who are hurting.
- The righteous have a language. It's a language of faith and covenant.

Numbers 13:25 - 14:9

- As the righteous have a certain language, there is another type of speech (weariness, doubt, fear, judgement, complaining, rebellion, etc.).
- This speech is evil when you forget about the power of the Lord, questioning His abilities (lack of faith). Being led by your own emotions, vision and thoughts.
 - We must always walk by faith and not by sight. If God has already done it, He will do it again. Remember the past faithfulness of God as we walk through situations finding assurance in Him.
 - Stay in a place of complete reliance on God. Our confidence isn't in our own prayers, it's in our God who answers prayers.
 - With a conversion, there will be controversy and adversity.
