Kept By the Covenant

1. Understanding the Nature of God and His Covenant

Scripture:

Genesis 17:1

• 2 Timothy 2:13 (NLT)

Genesis 22:14 (NLT)

Questions:

Am I living like God is enough for me?

Am I walking in awareness of His covenant?

Notes:

- We never have to question God's faithfulness. God reminds us that he provides. He is more than enough therefore we will never have a season of lack.
- The mindset of a covenant believer thinks of the blood that has already paid for it all. We don't have to DO anything to earn it, but we should be honoring His sacrifice.

2. Having a Mind Of a Covenant Believer

Scripture:

- Mark 9:23
- Hebrews 10:19-22

Questions:

Am I honoring the blood of Jesus with my daily words, thoughts and actions?

Notes:

- Anything is possible for those that believe.
- Have a heart that fully trusts God in every circumstance knowing that our past has been washed away. We don't have to hold onto that.

3. The New Covenant

Scripture:

- Luke 22:20
- Jeremiah 31:31-34

Questions:

What have I been holding onto that God's covenant already freed me from?

Notes:

• The cup is the new covenant between God and his people and it was sealed by the blood.

4. God's Covenant Is Our Inheritance

Scripture:

- Psalm 105:8-10
- Ephesians 2:12-13

Questions:

Do I walk daily as someone who is covered by the covenant?

Notes:

- God's covenant is eternal and generational.
- When we make a mistake and try to wash it away on our own, are we recognizing the
 covenant as ours? Repent and turn from the sin understanding that the covenant is the only
 true washing that is required.

5. Obedience Positions You For Fulfillment

Scripture:

- Genesis 12:1-4 (AMP)
- Genesis 15:5-6 (AMP)
- Genesis 17:7 (NLT)

Notes:

- Obedience and faith positions us to walk in God's presence.
- Obedience is the highest form of worship and faith is pleasing to the Lord.
- God will always be our God and the God of our descendants.

6. Jesus: The Fulfillment of the Covenant

Scripture:

- Genesis 22:13-14 (NLT)
- Exodus 12:12-13 (AMP)

Questions:

- Am I living in such a way that honors the sacrifice God made to keep His covenant with me?
 Notes:
 - Through Jesus, the fulfillment of the eternal covenant was completed. Through this covenant, we were given access to God and the ability to be redeemed from our past sins. His mercies are new every morning.
 - Abraham's ram was a foreshadow to Jesus who would be the true sacrificial lamb that God provided.
 - Someone has already died here!
