It's Time to Prosper, part 2

Scripture

~ We are supposed to prosper. ~

3 John 1:2 (AMP)

- You're supposed to be growing, maturing and in good health.
- We could be in poor health because we're stressed. Are we putting God first if we're allowing ourselves to become stressed?
- Prosperity everywhere else comes when we have spiritual prosperity.

Proverbs 28:13 (KJV)

 Continuously sinning and covering it up will not prosper. Admitting it and turning from it will bring prosperity and God's grace.

Deuteronomy 28:1-14 (NLT)

- "If" you obey means we have the choice to obey.
- If I'm hearing the voice of God and I'm obeying Him, doing all that he says to do, I will prosper in all things. My children will prosper, my enemies will flee, I will be blessed by the Lord where He tells me to be.
- I'm going to be exactly where the Lord tells me to be.

~ Do the word. Walk in blessings. ~

Luke 11:27-28 (AMPC)

- Jesus says those who do what God tells them to do are truly blessed.
- The God in you should be presentable in all situations and others should be able to benefit from it.

Job 36:11-16 (NLT)

- Listening and obeying God will lead to being blessed with prosperity throughout our lives; living a life of peace accepting that every situation is the will of God.
- Refusal leads to death. Making them full of resentment; refusing to cry out to him in difficult times when He's the one that will prosper them.

Psalm 112:1-10 (AMPC)

- The generation of the upright will be blessed. My children will prosper and anyone influenced by the God that is in me (spiritual offsprings) will prosper.
- Those that let God's light shine in all situations, doing what you're supposed to be doing (being
 just in all areas and helping others), will not be moved. They will have a steady heart fully
 confident in the Lord while they wait on their assured blessings from the Lord.
- When we are in a place where we are focused on the will and purpose of God, we won't be and shouldn't be focused on other people.

Takeaways

- When we prosper, we will find ourselves around others with similar mindsets.
- We should be running towards the arms of God instead of running from Him. He is the only one that can give us peace; "[that peace that reassures the heart, that peace] which transcends all understanding, [that peace which] stands guard over your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus [...]." (Philippians 4:7 AMP)
- Be done with pride. God gives grace to the humble hearted.
 - Allow Jesus to be a good example to us as he says he is "[...] gentle and humble in heart [...]. (Matthew 11:29 AMP)
 - Allow Him to make a good example out of us for others to see what to do, not the opposite.
