- Make sure you are operating where you're supposed to be. (Romans 12:6-8)
- Just because God is our protector, doesn't mean we won't go through things.
- When we go through trying seasons, it not only reveals Him to us, but it reveals us to Him.

Get Some Understanding About God

Scripture

Genesis 17:1-4a

- El Shaddai God Almighty (All Sufficient)
 - I have all I need in God, He is all I need.
- Our walk has to be correct so that we can experience more of Him.
 - When I'm praising the Lord, having a mindset of prosperity, thankful in all situations, praying, yielding to His will, etc, I'm in the right location.
- God makes and keeps His covenants with His people. What is a covenant?
 - In the Bible, a covenant is a binding agreement, a sacred pact, or a solemn promise between God and humanity, or between individuals. These covenants establish relationships, outline expectations, and often involve promises, conditions, and consequences. Covenants are central to understanding God's plan of redemption and His relationship with His people throughout biblical history.
 - o Original Word: בְּרִית
 - Part of Speech: Noun Feminine
 - Transliteration: briyth
 - Pronunciation: buh-REETHPhonetic Spelling: (ber-eeth')
 - KJV: confederacy, (con-)feder(-ate), covenant, league
 - NASB: covenant, treaty, league, allied, covenants
 - Word Origin: [from H1262 (ברה eat) (in the sense of cutting (like H1254 (ברא eat)))]

- 1. a compact (because made by passing between pieces of flesh)
- We are here today because of a covenant that God made with someone in the past. There is a covenant over our lives.
- When we go through things, we need to go to the covenant keeping God so that we can get to the proper location and then we will begin to see his provision.

Genesis 22:1-14a

- You need to be at the right location (in the presence of the Lord).
- God gives directives. Will we respond and be at the right location?
- If we aren't hearing from God, are we in the right location? Are you spending time with God?
- We go through seasons to reveal our faithfulness. Do we do what we're called to? (John 14:15)
