PPC Visitor Luncheon • Sunday, November 7

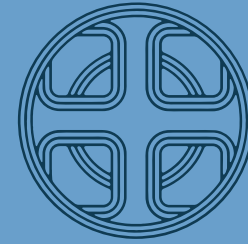
