John 3:1-8 – NLT

- 3 There was a man named Nicodemus, a Jewish religious leader who was a Pharisee. ² After dark one evening, he came to speak with Jesus. "Rabbi," he said, "we all know that God has sent you to teach us. Your miraculous signs are evidence that God is with you."
- ³ Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, unless you are born again, you cannot see the Kingdom of God."
- 4 "What do you mean?" exclaimed Nicodemus. "How can an old man go back into his mother's womb and be born again?"

If your heart is open to hear my voice and you open the door *within*, I will come in to you and feast with you, and you will feast with me. ²¹ And to the one who conquers I will give the privilege of sitting with me on my throne, just as I conquered and sat down with my Father on his throne.

This is the mighty power ²⁰ that was released when God raised Christ from the dead and exalted him to the place of highest honor and supreme authority in the heavenly realm! ²¹ And now
