Proverbs 11:24-26

- **Matthew 7:21-23** –
21 “Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. 22 Many will say to me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name and in your name drive out demons and in your name perform many miracles?’ 23 Then I will tell them plainly, ‘I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!’

He knew her in the Biblical Sense

Genesis 4:1,17,25 – eth, yada

- To know, To have knowledge of, aware
- Yada, yada, yada

Luke 1:34 – How can this be since I know not a man

Matthew 1:25 – Adam knew not Mary his wife –

- ghin-oce-ko – To know absolutely - through personal experience, aware, be sure

Consummation

- the action of making a marriage or relationship complete by having sexual intercourse.
- the point at which something is complete or finalized.
- "the consummation of a sale"

To know someone in the Biblical sense...through sexual intercourse is an experience reserved by God for a husband a wife.

Cleave – Join Together

Man leaves father and mother...two become one flesh!
Our Spirit and God's Spirit become one spirit! – Romans 8:16, 1 Co 6:17

Be Careful What You Cleave To!!

- You never know what will cleave to you!
- Knit together...soul ties. God can break them, but they can be difficult to break or move past.

Matthew 26:69-74 (NIV)– Peter

69 Now Peter was sitting out in the courtyard, and a servant girl came to him. “You also were with Jesus of Galilee,” she said.

70 But he denied it before them all. “I don’t know what you’re talking about,” he said.

71 Then he went out to the gateway, where another servant girl saw him and said to the people there, “This fellow was with Jesus of Nazareth.”

72 He denied it again, with an oath: “I don’t know the man!”

73 After a little while, those standing there went up to Peter and said, “Surely you are one of them; your accent gives you away.”

74 Then he began to call down curses, and he swore to them, “I don’t know the man!”

- Easy to deny someone with whom you've never known...

John 17:3 –

3 Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.

Depart from me worker of iniquity I never knew you:

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Difference Between Using and Knowing the Name:

- We USED your name but we never KNEW it!
 - We never knew you!! You never knew us!
- **Acts 19:13-16** –
13 Some Jews who went around driving out evil spirits tried to invoke the name of the Lord Jesus over those who were demon-possessed. They would say, “In the name of the Jesus whom Paul preaches, I command you to come out.” 14 Seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, were doing this. 15 One day the evil spirit answered them, “Jesus I know, and Paul I know about, but who are you?” 16 Then the man who had the evil spirit jumped on them and overpowered them all. He

gave them such a beating that they ran out of the house naked and bleeding.

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Complete coming together...Complete in Him!!

- You Complete Me...Jerry McGwire
 - Complete In Him...Lacking Nothing!

- **Colossians 2:10-15** (NLT)– Complete In Him!
 - 10 So you also are complete through your union with Christ, who is the head over every ruler and authority.
 - 11 When you came to Christ, you were “circumcised,” but not by a physical procedure. Christ performed a spiritual circumcision—the cutting away of your sinful nature.
 - 12 For you were buried with Christ when you were baptized. And with him you were raised to new life because you trusted the mighty power of God, who raised Christ from the dead.
 - 13 You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins.
 - 14 He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.
 - 15 In this way, he disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by his victory over them on the cross.

Worker of Iniquity

- Iniquity means Violation of Law, Transgression, Unrighteousness
- Believer...Not a Worker!!

Galatians 4:6-9 – Known

6 Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, “*Abba, Father.*” 7 So you are no longer a slave, but God’s child; and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir.

8 Formerly, when you did not know God, you were slaves to those who by nature are not gods. 9 But now that you know God—or rather are known by God—how is it that you are turning back to those weak and miserable forces?

(Earlier in sermon reference how some will have relations with someone only to be rejected or it is seen as nothing.) Have you experienced something so intimate...so beautiful and so complete happens that you will never deny God and God will never deny you!!

Holy Spirit!!

Romans 10:13-14 –

13 For “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

14 But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if

they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?

John 8:31-32 –

31 To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, “If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. 32 Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

John 14:15-17 –

15 “If you love me, keep my commands. 16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— 17 the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.
