Exodus 3:1-15

**>>> KEY THOUGHT**

Moses was a man living in a land that was not his land with a people who were not his people. He was running from not only the past and what he'd done...but He was running from who He was. Moses spent the first 80 years of his life struggling to find his identity and his purpose. Then, God called Moses from the burning bush. Moses responded..."Here I Am!" In one moment of surrender, God changed His Legacy!

**>>> DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. How might Moses's upbringing have been confusing for him?
2. What was Moses running away from when he fled to Midian?
3. When God called Moses from the burning bush Moses responded, "Here I Am". After God told Moses what He wanted, he changed his response to "Who Am I?"
  - o Why did Moses change his response?
  - o What does this reveal about his own struggle with identity and what he was *really* running from?
4. God sent Moses back to Egypt to lead his people, the Israelites, and to stand up to and against Pharaoh.
  - o Going back to confront your past can be scary! How can a strong sense of identity help a person face their past?
  - o What would Moses's Legacy have been had he not went back to Egypt?

**Discussion:**

Are there things from your past God is sending you back to rectify, or face, since you've become a Christian?

- Was your response, "Here I Am" or "Who Am I"?
