 <sup>16</sup> For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

#### **PERISH – APOLLOMEE**

To Destroy Fully, Die, Lose

- Able to Perish...able to be destroyed, Able to Die,
   Able to Lose
- Incorruptible Not subject to rot, decay or death;
   Everlasting

# Not will that any should PERISH

- <u>2 Peter 3:9</u> NKJV <u>Imperishable/Repentance</u> <sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.
- Matthew 8:23-26 NKJV Save Us We Perish <sup>23</sup> Now when He got into a boat, His disciples followed Him. <sup>24</sup> And suddenly a great tempest arose on the sea, so that the boat was covered with the waves. But He was asleep. <sup>25</sup> Then His disciples came to *Him* and awoke Him, saying, "Lord, save us! We are perishing!"<sup>26</sup> But He said to them, "Why are you fearful, O you of little faith?" Then He arose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm.

#### • <u>Luke 13:1-5</u> – NKJV – Repent or Perish

13 There were present at that season some who told Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. <sup>2</sup> And Jesus answered and said to them, "Do you suppose that these Galileans were worse sinners than all *other* Galileans, because they suffered such things? <sup>3</sup> I tell you, no; but unless you **repent you will all likewise perish**. <sup>4</sup> Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them, do you think that they were worse sinners than all *other* men who dwelt in Jerusalem? <sup>5</sup> I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish."

# **Prodigal Son** – Repent

 Was starving...lost everything. "How many people in my Father's house have bread enough to spare, yet I am <u>perishing</u> with hunger...I will arise and go to my Father and tell him I have sinned before you and before Heaven...I am not worthy!"

When we Repent...we are Forgiven!

1 John 1:9 – NIV – After Repentance-Forgiveness <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

# Jews Challenge Jesus to tell them plainly if He is the Christ

• John 10:22-30 – NKJV – Eternal Life

<sup>22</sup> Now it was the Feast of Dedication in Jerusalem, and it was winter. <sup>23</sup> And Jesus walked in the temple, in Solomon's porch. <sup>24</sup> Then the Jews surrounded Him and said to Him, "How long do You keep us in doubt? If You are the Christ, tell us plainly." <sup>25</sup> Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. <sup>26</sup> But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. <sup>27</sup> My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. <sup>28</sup> And I give them eternal life, and they shall never **perish**; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. <sup>29</sup> My Father,

who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of My Father's hand. <sup>30</sup> I and *My* Father are one."

# **Incorruptible God**

Romans 1:22-23 – NKJV – God is Incurrptible
<sup>22</sup> Professing to be wise, they became fools, <sup>23</sup> and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible (fthar-tos: decayed or perishable) man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.

• He wears an incorruptible crown

# <u>1 Peter 1:3-10,13</u> – NKJV – Salvation is Incorruptible

<sup>3</sup> Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, <sup>4</sup> to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, <sup>5</sup> who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

<sup>6</sup> In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, <sup>7</sup> that the genuineness of your faith, *being* much

more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, 8 whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see *Him*, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, 9 receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of *your* souls.

<sup>10</sup> Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace *that would come* to you,

<sup>13</sup> Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest *your* hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

If there is no resurrection of the dead then Christ is died in vain

But a body...(corruptible body) Made like corruptible man

Half Dead – Alive on the Outside...Dead on the Inside...Come Alive

- What is on the Outside is temporary
  - Flesh and Blood will not inherit everlasting life
  - o Spirit, Body, Soul
