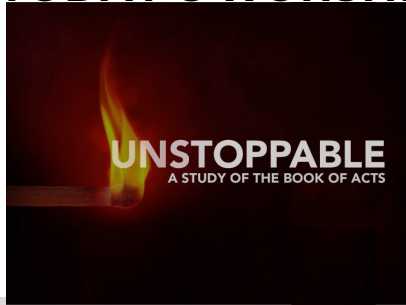



# TODAY'S WORSHIP
