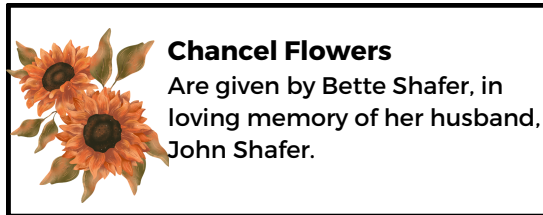


TOGETHER in THANKFULNESS:

1 Chronicles 16:8-11

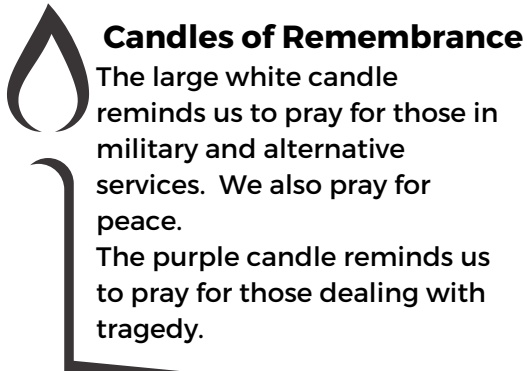

The large white candle reminds us to pray for those in military and alternative services. We also pray for peace.

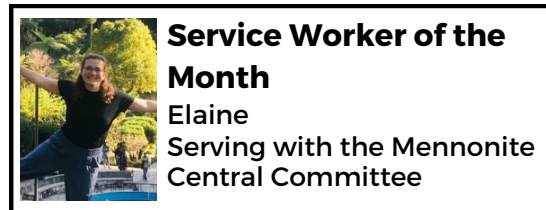
The purple candle reminds us to pray for those dealing with tragedy.

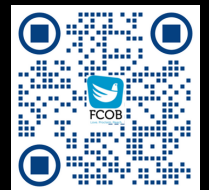
