WEEK 5- UNSTOPPABLE: FULL POWER OR NO POWER

BIG IDEA:

You are unstoppable! It's either full power or no power! Philippians 4:13 illustrates the idea of full power: *I can do all this through him who gives me strength*. And in John 15:5b, Jesus describes the opposite, no power: *apart from me you can do nothing*. In the movie *Unstoppable*, Denzel Washington's character describes the destructive power of a run-away train: *"a million pounds of train going that fast will vaporize anything in its path."* Together, when we are on full power, we are unstoppable! The Chuuuuuuuuurch is unstoppable!

KEY VERSE:

Matt 28:18-20 "Jesus came and told his disciples, 'I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.'"

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Key Point #1: We are unstoppable because we believe

1. What does it mean to be changed, transformed, and set free?

Key Point #2: We are unstoppable because we have authority in Jesus' name

2. How does being given authority change the way you live, think, and make decisions?
3. What does the name of Jesus signify? What makes it powerful?
4. Is the idea that Jesus has given you the authority to act on his behalf challenging for you to accept? Do you live like this is true? Do you pray like this is true?

Key Point #3: We are unstoppable because we are not alone

5. What does it mean to be filled with the Holy Spirit? How do you know when you are operating in the power of the Holy Spirit?
6. How can you recognize the enemy's attacks? How can you respond to them?

Key Point #4: We are unstoppable because we are together

7. What does togetherness look like in this season?

MOVING FORWARD:

The church is an unstoppable chain! It is one body with different parts, ALL are important to the accomplishment of OUR mission to do whatever it takes to Follow, Grow, and Live for Jesus. You are the Church to the people around you. As a group, share what you feel the Holy Spirit is calling you to do. Is the Holy Spirit calling you to take the first step and believe? Or is He calling you to engage or more fully engage? What step can you take this week?
