WEEK 6 – CHOOSING THE BEST-GOD’S PERSPECTIVE

BIG IDEA:

We're all in uncharted territory, things look really different right now! Our routines and environments have all shifted. How we respond in the midst of the change and uncertainty, is up to us.

KEY VERSE:

Luke 10:38-42, *“As Jesus and his disciples were on their way, he came to a village where a woman named Martha opened her home to him. She had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord’s feet listening to what he said. But Martha was distracted by all the preparations that had to be made. She came to him and asked, “Lord, don’t you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!” “Martha, Martha,” the Lord answered, “you are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed—or indeed only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her.”*

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Where is God inviting you to reap a harvest? How can you step more fully into your relationships with your family? With the Lord?

Key Point #1: You're Either Opting into Isolation or Communication

2. Do you tend toward isolation or communication? Has that changed? Has it been challenging for you to stay connected to community?

Key Point #2: You either Choose your Perspective or God’s Perspective

3. Do you feel distracted from your relationship with Jesus? What is it that has been pulling you from that connection with Him and what can you do to counter-act this?

Key Point #3: You either trust in your own preparation or God's provision

4. When in situations that feel out of control, do you tend toward pride or fear?
5. How can you be more intentional in listening to Jesus? What does that look like? In what environment do you best hear from the Lord and how can you create that space in your life right now?

Key Point #4: You're Either Being the church, or You're Not.

6. Are you being the church?

There is a harvest to reap in your relationship with God, your marriage, your family. There is a harvest to reach as a collective church through this online platform. Don't let distractions rob you of opportunities to grow closer with God. As a group, share what you feel has been stealing your focus?
