

# All Or Nothing

## WEEK 1- IT'S FOR EVERYONE OR NO ONE

### BIG IDEA:

This series is where we are establishing the purpose and mission of the Church. It is our desire that Hope Church is a place where it is ok to not be ok. Jesus won't leave you in that place. He can and will change every aspect of your life.

### KEY VERSE:

Romans 3:10 *"As it is written: There is no one perfect, not even one."*

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Why is it so important that Hope Church be inclusive? And why might this be challenging?

**Key Point #1: It's Either Everyone is Invited or No One is Invited.**

2. Why are we so drawn to exclusivity?

**Key Point #2: It's Either Jesus for Everyone or No One.**

3. As our Church grows larger, what can you do personally to make sure that new people do not get lost in the crowd?
4. What does it look like to intentionally connect with new people and invite them into you community? Does this come naturally to you? Is this challenging? What steps could you take to be bolder in this area?

**Key Point #3: It's Either Following Jesus or Following Religion.**

5. What is it that you bring to Hope Church? Are you fully utilizing those gifts? If not, why not?

**Key Point #4: It's Either Jesus' Way or Our Way.**

6. Have you been through Next Steps? Are you fully engaged at Hope Church helping us accomplish our mission? (e.g., on the Hope Team, consistently attending, personally running after Jesus, giving, sharing, Partnering). If so, share how this experience has been fulfilling for you. If not, what is it that is holding you back?

### MOVING FORWARD:

It's all or nothing for us all. Either the church is for everyone or the church isn't for anyone. Either every person matters or no one does. It's either all about Jesus or it's not. Our church is all in on Jesus. This church is exclusively inclusive; everyone is welcome. As a group, discuss what it is that makes it hard for you to be inclusive? What do you need to change this week to grow in this area?
