

Find Your Calling

WEEK 1: CHOOSING THE HARD RIGHT

BIG IDEA:

There is a calling on your life. God is always calling, the problem is that either we are not listening or we are stubborn. The closer you get to doing what God wants, the more opposition you'll face. The enemy doesn't want you to walk in faith and obedience. Don't worry when you face opposition, worry when you don't.

KEY VERSES:

Haggai 1:2-8, This is what the LORD Almighty says: "These people say, 'The time has not yet come to rebuild the LORD's house.' Then the word of the LORD came through the prophet Haggai: "Is it a time for you yourselves to be living in your paneled houses, while this house remains a ruin?" Now this is what the LORD Almighty says: "Give careful thought to your ways. You have planted much but harvested little. You eat, but never have enough. You drink, but never have your fill. You put on clothes but are not warm. You earn wages, only to put them in a purse with holes in it." This is what the LORD Almighty says: "Give careful thought to your ways. Go up into the mountains and bring down timber and build my house, so that I may take pleasure in it and be honored," says the LORD.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. How do you know what God wants you to do?

Key Point #1: Choose the hard right over the easy wrong

2. What is God calling you to do that you keep putting off, perhaps because it is hard? What is the unfinished thing that God has put on your heart?
3. What do you dream about, what are you passionate about, what the things that God has put in your heart to work toward?

Key Point #2: Too often we put our comfort over our calling

4. Do you believe that God has a calling on your life? What affect does that have on your day-to-day life?
5. What is God building in you right now?

Key Point #3: The way to get started is to quit talking and start doing

6. What do you need to do to follow God's will? What is the hard thing that you are avoiding right now? What is holding you back?

MOVING FORWARD:

Everything you need to step into your calling has already been provided. It may take a lot of work, but if you choose to do the right thing, it always produces the right results. Trust God's calling for your life and trust His spirit to guide, direct, and empower you.
