- 2. How can understanding this relationship deepen your view of marriage?

Reflection and Prayer:

Pray for your marriage (or future marriage) to reflect the relationship between Christ and the Church.

Day 5: Practical Applications

Additional Reading:

Colossians 3:18-19

Questions:

- 1. What are some practical ways to live out leaving, cleaving, and oneness principles?
- 2. What are some areas in your life where these principles need more attention?
- 3. What are some goals you could set to put these principles in action in your relationship?

Reflection and Prayer:

Pray God reveals any areas in your life that may need more attention and ask for His guidance to change.
