1 Cor 7:32-35

Day 1: Read 1 Cor 7; Consider the overall purpose and content of this section. What purpose does this text from the Word of God serve? Spend some time praying over the context, meaning, and the application of the text.

Day 2: Today, consider the context of these verses. Paul states that the "world is passing away"; what does he mean? What other passages come to mind and would be related to this passage? What are some implications of marrying or not marrying the text brings forth?

Day 3: The passages here lay out the priority of worshipping God and serving Him. How could marriage be a distraction from this? In what ways could it compliment?

Day 4: Based on these passages and elated interlinking passages what advice would you have to a single person who is considering whether they should be married?

Day 5: Based on these passages and elated interlinking passages what advice would you have to a married person who is considering whether they should be divorced?

Day 6: Today if you are married, spend time praying over your marriage, the gift of your spouse, the beauty of marriage, and your future serving Christ. If you are single, spend time praying over your relationship with Christ, and the many mercies and kindnesses the Lord has provided to you.
