

**Bible Study Guide - *Battlefield of the Mind – Peace of Mind* - Text: Romans 12:1–2**

**Key Scripture** - “Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.” — Romans 12:2

**Study Introduction**

Many people struggle with anxiety, worry, distraction, and mental exhaustion. Even when life appears calm externally, there can still be unrest internally. God never intended for believers to live in constant confusion and mental chaos. Through the renewing power of the Holy Spirit and the truth of God’s Word, we can reclaim peace of mind.

This study explores three important truths about renewing the mind and learning to walk in peace.

**1 — Surrender Precedes Transformation**

**Key Scriptures**

“Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God.” — Romans 12:1

“Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.” — James 4:7

**Discussion Questions**

**Application**

**2 — Stop Conforming, Start Renewing**

**Key Scriptures**

“Do not conform to the pattern of this world.” — Romans 12:2

“If you continue in My word... you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.” — John 8:31–32

“You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.” — Isaiah 26:3

“Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts.” — Colossians 3:15

**Discussion Questions**

### **3 — Transformation Leads to Clarity**

#### **Key Scriptures**

“Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.” — Romans 12:2

“You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You.” — Isaiah 26:3

#### **Discussion Questions**

##### **Three Responses**

###### **1. Surrender Every Area Daily**

Give God your thoughts, fears, plans, and concerns every day.

###### **2. Limit Negative Influences**

Reduce distractions and influences that pull your mind away from God's truth.

###### **3. Replace Noise with Truth**

Spend daily time in Scripture and allow God's truth to shape your thinking.
