

# REVELATION

## Chapter 1- week 3

**REV 1:4** *John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne,*

1) **Grace to you and Peace**... Grace, which is the favor of God that gives to you access to the power of God for everything you need for life and Godliness. Peace, which is greek word “Eirene”, which means “at one again.” God’s favor that gives you access to him and the unity of “at one again” with God the gives to you strength to overcome and endure anything.

**2 Pet 1:2-4** Grace and peace **be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord,**<sup>3</sup> as His divine power has given to us all things that *pertain* to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue,<sup>4</sup> by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption *that is* in the world through lust.

## 2) From Him who is and who was and who is to come...

*Rev 1:8, 4:8, 11:17, 16:5*

**Mal 3:6** “For I *am* the Lord, I do not change;  
Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob.

**Heb 13:8** Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and  
forever.

## WHO IS....

**Col 1:15** He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn  
over all creation.

**Col 1:18** And He is the head of the body, the church, who is  
the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He  
may have the preeminence.

**Mat 11:29** Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I  
am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your  
souls.

**Mark 14:61-62** Again the high priest asked Him, saying to  
Him, “Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?”

<sup>62</sup> Jesus said, “I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at  
the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of  
heaven.”

**John 6:35** And Jesus said to them, “I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.

**John 8:12** Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, “I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life.”

**John 10:11** I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.

**John 11:25** Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.

## WHO WAS...

**John 8:59** Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM.”

**John 1:1-3** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

**Col 1:16-17** For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. <sup>17</sup> And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.

# WHO IS TO COME...

**Mat 24:30** Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

**Mat 16:27** For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.

**Rev 11:15** Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “The kingdoms of this world have become *the kingdoms* of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!”

**Rev 19:11-21** Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. <sup>12</sup> His eyes *were* like a flame of fire, and on His head *were* many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. <sup>13</sup> He *was* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. <sup>14</sup> And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. <sup>15</sup> Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He

Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. <sup>16</sup> And He has on *His* robe and on His thigh a name written:

## KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS

### *The Beast and His Armies Defeated*

<sup>17</sup> Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, “Come and gather together for the supper of the great God, <sup>18</sup> that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all *people*, free and slave, both small and great.”

<sup>19</sup> And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. <sup>20</sup> Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone. <sup>21</sup> And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

REV 1:8 *“I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End,” says the Lord, “who*

*is and who was and who is to come, the  
Almighty.” ...*

## THE ALMIGHTY

Thayers : He who holds sway over All things, The Ruler of ALL. ... the *all-ruling*, i.e. *God* (as absolute and universal *sovereign*):—Almighty, Omnipotent. *THE ALL POWERFUL*

**Job 22:21-30** “Now *acquaint yourself with Him*, and be at peace;

Thereby good will come to you.

<sup>22</sup> Receive, please, instruction from His mouth,  
And lay up His words in your heart.

<sup>23</sup> If you return to the Almighty (*THE ALL POWERFUL*), you  
will be built up;

You will remove iniquity far from your tents.

<sup>24</sup> Then you will lay your gold in the dust,  
And the *gold* of Ophir among the stones of the brooks.

<sup>25</sup> Yes, the Almighty (*THE ALL POWERFUL*) will be your  
gold

And your precious silver;

<sup>26</sup> For then you will have your delight in the Almighty (*THE ALL POWERFUL*)

And lift up your face to God.

<sup>27</sup> You will make your prayer to Him,  
He will hear you,  
And you will pay your vows.

- 28 You will also declare a thing,  
And it will be established for you;  
So light will shine on your ways.
- 29 When they cast *you* down, and you say, ‘Exaltation *will come!*’  
Then He will save the humble *person*.
- 30 He will *even* deliver one who is not innocent;  
Yes, he will be delivered by the purity of your hands.”

**Job 22:29-30 NLT** If people are in trouble and you say, ‘Help them,’ God will save them.

30 Even sinners will be rescued;  
they will be rescued because your hands are pure.”

**Job 33:4** The Spirit of God has made me,  
And the breath of the Almighty (**THE ALL POWERFUL**)  
gives me life.

**Job 32:8** But *there is* a spirit in man,  
And the breath of the Almighty (**THE ALL POWERFUL**)  
gives him understanding.

**Psa 91:1** He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High  
Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty (**THE ALL POWERFUL**).

**Isa 13:6** Wail, for the day of the Lord *is* at hand!  
It will come as destruction from the Almighty (**THE ALL POWERFUL**).

**2 Cor 6:18** I will be a Father to you,  
*And you shall be My sons and daughters,*  
*Says the Lord Almighty. (THE ALL POWERFUL).*

**REV 11:15-19** The kingdoms of this world have become the  
kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign  
forever and ever!”<sup>16</sup> And the twenty-four elders who sat  
before God on their thrones fell on their faces and  
worshiped God,<sup>17</sup> saying:

“We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, (THE ALL  
POWERFUL)

The One who is and who was and who is to come,  
Because You have taken Your great power and reigned.

<sup>18</sup> The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come,  
And the time of the dead, that they should be judged,  
And that You should reward Your servants the prophets and  
the saints,  
And those who fear Your name, small and great,  
And should destroy those who destroy the earth.”

<sup>19</sup> Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark  
of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were  
lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.
