## REVELATION PT 9

REV 1:8 "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty." ... REV 1:11a saying, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last,"

10) I am the ALPHA and the Omega, The First and the Last.

Rev 22:12-13 "And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward *is* with Me, to give to every one according to his work. <sup>13</sup> I am the Alpha and the Omega, *the* Beginning and *the* End, the First and the Last."

Jesus is before all and after all. He was there BEFORE the Beginning and will be there AFTER the END. He is the capstone of ALL TIME / SPACE / and DIMENTIONS. He is Before and After.

John 1:1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning

with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

Psa 33:6-21 By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, And all the host of them by the breath of His mouth.

- He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deep in storehouses.
- 8 Let all the earth fear the Lord; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.
- For He spoke, and it was *done*;He commanded, and it stood fast.
- <sup>10</sup> The Lord brings the counsel of the nations to nothing; He makes the plans of the peoples of no effect.
- <sup>11</sup> The counsel of the Lord stands forever, The plans of His heart to all generations.
- <sup>12</sup> Blessed *is* the nation whose God *is* the Lord, The people He has chosen as His own inheritance.
- 13 The Lord looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men.
- <sup>14</sup> From the place of His dwelling He looks On all the inhabitants of the earth;
- <sup>15</sup> He fashions their hearts individually; He considers all their works.
- <sup>16</sup> No king *is* saved by the multitude of an army; A mighty man is not delivered by great strength.
- <sup>17</sup> A horse *is* a vain hope for safety; Neither shall it deliver *any* by its great strength.
- <sup>18</sup> Behold, the eye of the Lord is on those who fear Him,

- On those who hope in His mercy,
- <sup>19</sup> To deliver their soul from death, And to keep them alive in famine.
- <sup>20</sup> Our soul waits for the Lord; He *is* our help and our shield.
- <sup>21</sup> For our heart shall rejoice in Him, Because we have trusted in His holy name.
  - Col 1:15-18 He is the image of the invisible God, *the firstborn over all creation.* <sup>16</sup> For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. <sup>17</sup> *And He is before all things*, and in Him all things consist. <sup>18</sup> And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.
  - **Col 1:16-17amp** For it was in Him that all things were created, in heaven and on earth, things seen and things unseen, whether thrones, dominions, rulers, or authorities; all things were created *and* exist through Him [by His service, intervention] and in *and* for Him.
- 17 And He Himself existed before all things, and in Him all things consist (cohere, are held together).
- Heb 1:2-3 amp [But] in the last of these days He has spoken to us in [the person of a] Son, Whom He appointed Heir *and* lawful Owner of all things, also by *and* through Whom He created the worlds *and* the reaches of space *and* the ages of time

[He made, produced, built, operated, and arranged them in order].

3 He is the sole expression of the glory of God [the Lightbeing, the out-raying or radiance of the divine], and He is the perfect imprint *and* very image of [God's] nature, upholding *and* maintaining *and* guiding *and* propelling the universe by His mighty word of power. When He had *by offering Himself* accomplished *our* cleansing of sins *and* riddance of guilt, He sat down at the right hand of the divine Majesty on high,

Psa 102:25-27 Of old You laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens *are* the work of Your hands.

- They will perish, but You will endure;
  Yes, they will all grow old like a garment;
  Like a cloak You will change them,
  And they will be changed.
- 27 But You *are* the same, And Your years will have no end.
