

# REVELATION

## Faithful Witness

**REV 1:5** *and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth.*

**Rev 3:14** These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God:

Faithful= worthy of full trust

True = real! not imaginary! being according to fact

**Rev 19:11** Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

The faithfulness of God.

**2 tim 2:13.** If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.

Deny. ....verbal renounce knowledge or relationship (Mt 10:33; Lk 8:45); 2. LN 34.48 deny, disown, repudiate, the focus of possibly non-verbal denial (Lk 12:9) refuse to agree, not consent to (Heb 11:24); 4. LN 30.52 disregard, pay no attention to, deny oneself

It is utterly impossible for Jesus not to be faithful and true. If God wasn't true for one moment. One instant. The entire universe unravel. The entire universe is upheld by His word which Is Truth.

**Hebrew 1:3 amp.** He is the sole expression of the glory of God [the Light-being, the out-raying or radiance of the divine], and He is the perfect imprint and very image of [God's] nature, upholding and maintaining and guiding and propelling the universe by His mighty word of power. When He had by offering Himself accomplished our cleansing of sins and riddance of guilt, He sat down at the right hand of the divine Majesty on high, (Hebrews 1:3 AMP)

**John 17:17.** Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.

### *Jesus was faithful to the father...*

**Heb 3:1-2** Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus, <sup>2</sup> who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also *was faithful* in all His house.

Witness. =. Jesus came to reveal the Father to the world.

**John 17:3-4** And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent. <sup>4</sup> I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do.

**John 17:6-8** “I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word. <sup>7</sup> Now they have known that all things which You have given Me are from You. <sup>8</sup> For I have given to them the words which You have given Me; and they have received *them*, and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me.

**John 17:25-26** O righteous Father! The world has not known You, but I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me. <sup>26</sup> ***And I have declared to them Your name,*** and will declare *it, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them,* and I in them.”

**John 14:8-14** Philip said to Him, “Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us.”

<sup>9</sup> Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, ‘Show us the Father’? <sup>10</sup> Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own *authority*; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. <sup>11</sup> Believe Me that I *am* in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.

<sup>12</sup> “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, ***because I go to My Father.*** <sup>13</sup> And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. <sup>14</sup> If you ask anything in My name, I will do *it*.

*Jesus promised he would send the Holy Spirit when he went to his father.*

**John 15:26.** “But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me. (John 15:26 NKJV)

*We are to be faithful witnesses, revealing to the world who Jesus really is.....*

**John 20:21-22.** So Jesus said to them again, “Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you.” And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit. (John 20:21-22 NKJV)

Jesus sent us the Holy Spirit so we could be faithful witnesses.

**Acts 1:8.** But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” (Acts 1:8 NKJV)
