It will never seek anything but the highest good for another person. It does not need a chemistry, an affinity, or a feeling. It is love that endures through any circumstance or difficulty. Agape is a love that exclusively belongs to God and God's people.

Galatians 5 The fruit of the spirit is love...

Galatians 5:16-17 the flesh lusts against the spirit, and the spirit against the flesh, and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. If you're led by the spirit, you're not under the law. Now, the works of the flesh are evident, which are adultery, fornication, uncleanness, rudeness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like.

For even sinners love those who love them. 33 If you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same.
