Warning Sign Match

Materials

Game cards (following pages)
Optional: tape or poster putty

Instructions

Print on card stock (or thick paper) and cut out two or four sets of game cards, depending on how many students or teams are playing and how long the game should last. Lay the cards out facedown. Turn over two cards at a time—if the cards match, keep them and take another turn. Otherwise turn them back over and allow the next player to take a turn. Cards with a picture of Amos count as a wild card and can be matched with any other card. After all the cards are used, have students count up the pairs of cards they collected to determine a winner.

Option 1: Divide the class into teams. Lay several sets of cards out facedown on the floor or use tape or poster putty to stick them up on the wall. Have each team work together to match pairs of cards.

Option 2: Have each student or teams of two race each other or against the clock to match pairs of cards.


Suggested Discussion

We learned today how God showed his great love and mercy toward the people of Israel. Even though they kept doing sinful things, God patiently waited and sent warnings to them for 250 years!









