Review Questions

- **1.** What were the Israelites commanded to destroy at Jericho? Everything except for the precious metals (gold, silver, bronze, iron).
- 2. Who sinned by disobeying the command to bring devoted things to the priests? *Achan.*
- 3. Why did Israel lose the first battle at Ai? Because of Achan's sin.
- **4.** Name a commandment that Achan broke. You shall not covet. You shall not steal.
- 5. What items did Achan take? Cloak, 200 shekels of silver, bar of gold.
- 6. Where did Achan hide the things he took? In a hole in his tent.
- 7. What did Joshua and the people have to do to Achan and his family? Destroy them.
- **8.** What happened at the second battle at Ai? Did Israel win or lose? They won and destroyed the city and its people.
- **9.** How did Israel defeat Ai in the second battle? What strategy did they use? Ambush and diversion by leading Ai's men away while the others burned the city then closed in from behind.
- 10. What people tricked Israel into making a promise of peace with them? Gibeonites.
- 11. How did the Gibeonites trick Israel into thinking they were from a distant land? They brought old bread and dressed in worn-out sandals and clothes.
- 12. Joshua let the Gibeonites live because of his promise, but what did he make them become? Servants.
- 13. Who was angry with the Gibeonites and surrounded their city? Five Amorite kings.
- **14.** Who came to save the Gibeonites? *Joshua and his army.*
- **15.** How did God help Israel in the battle against the Amorites? God made their enemies panic. He sent hailstones down on their enemies.
- **16.** The Amorites were running away when Joshua prayed. What did he ask God to do? Make the sun stand still so it would remain daytime until he could catch the enemy.
- 17. How long did God keep the sun up for Joshua? About a day.
- 18. What did Israel do after the five kings were killed? They took over the kings' cities and land.

Bonus: What tribe was Achan from? Judah.

Bonus: Name one of the consequences of Achan's sin. Allow several students to answer. It removed God's blessing on the Israelites. God was angry with the Israelites. They lost a battle. Over 30 fighting men died.
