- 4. The second commandment reminds us that we should not make or worship what? Idols.

- **6.** What is the third commandment? You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
- 7. What does the third commandment mean we should do? Honor God with our words.
- 8. The fourth commandment reminds us to keep what day holy? Sabbath day.
