1. What do we call the commands God gave Moses and the Israelites at Mount Sinai? *The Ten Commandments.*
2. What command is given in our memory verse? It's the first commandment. *You shall have no other gods before me.*
3. What does the first commandment mean we should do? *Put God first.*
4. The second commandment reminds us that we should not make or worship what? *Idols.*
5. Who is the only one we should worship? *God.*
6. What is the third commandment? *You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.*
7. What does the third commandment mean we should do? *Honor God with our words.*
8. The fourth commandment reminds us to keep what day holy? *Sabbath day.*
9. What does the fourth commandment mean? *Take time for God.*
