K-1st Review Questions

1. What was the place of worship called, which God instructed the Israelites to build? *The tabernacle.*
2. What were the two parts of the tabernacle? A fence with a tall building in the middle or a fence with a tent in the middle? *A fence with a tent in the middle.*
3. What were animals sacrificed on in the tabernacle? *The (bronze) altar.*
4. What item did the priests use for washing? *The basin. Bronze basin.*
5. What were the two rooms in the tent of meeting called? *The holy place and the most holy place.*
6. What separated the two rooms in the tent of meeting? *A veil. A curtain.*
7. What was the golden lampstand for? *Light inside the tent (so the priest could see).*
8. What was placed on the table every week, twelve loaves of bread or bitter herbs? *Twelve loaves of bread.*
9. What did the bread remind the people of? *How God provided manna in the wilderness.*
10. What was kept burning on the altar of incense, sweet-smelling spices or sweet-smelling flowers? *Sweet-smelling spices.*
11. Who was allowed into the most holy place? *The high priest.*
12. What was the ark of the covenant, a big ship like Noah's or a box covered in gold? *A box covered in gold.*
13. What kind of decoration was on top of the ark of the covenant? *Cherubim. Angels.*
14. What piece of furniture had the mercy seat where the high priest asked for God's forgiveness and mercy? *The ark of the covenant.*

15. Most of the furnishings, like the ark of the covenant, were made with a shiny, yellow metal. What was that metal? *Gold.*
16. Who was the first high priest? *Aaron.*
17. Name one of the colors used to make the priests' special clothes. *Gold, blue, purple, and red.*
18. The animal sacrifices were a picture of someone who sacrificed himself to save sinners. Who was that? *Jesus.*
19. Who can say the memory verse? *Allow several students to try reciting the verse.*
