- 2. Who had a vision of a ram and a goat? Daniel.
- 3. What did the goat in Daniel's vision do to the ram? The goat attacked and killed the ram.
- 4. In Daniel's dream, the goat stood for which kingdom: Persia, Greece, or China? *Greece*.
- 5. The horn on the goat's head stood for what powerful ruler of Greece? Alexander the Great.
- 6. One Greek ruler hated the Jews. What did he try to force the people to do? *Worship false gods*.
- 7. What did the nickname *Maccabee* mean: wrench, hammer, or nail? *Hammer*.
- 8. What Jewish festival celebrates the time they took back the temple and relit the lampstands: Day of Atonement, Passover, or Hanukkah? *Hanukkah*.
