P What You Heard In the Word

- Godcalled Jeremiah to behis prophet and deliver God's message of coming disaster to the people of Judah.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- 1. What did the potter do to the spoiled clay? *He smashed it and started over.*
- 2. What did the priest do to Jeremiah because he didn't like his message of warning? He beat Jeremiah and put him in stocks.
