

Ten Commandments Bookmark

Materials

- ☐ Ten Commandments pictures (next page)
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Crayons or markers
- ☐ Glue
- ☐ Construction paper cut into 2-inch x 10-inch strips
- ☐ Narrow ribbon
- ☐ Hole punch

Instructions

Print one set of Ten Commandments pictures for each student. Have students color and cut out each picture. Glue the first five pictures on the construction paper strip. Turn over and glue the other five onto the back, allowing the construction paper to show around the edges. Punch a hole at the top and tie a ribbon on the end. Note: remind the students to let these dry before inserting into a book!

Suggested Discussion

God gave the Ten Commandments to the Israelites to show them how they should act toward him and toward each other. These laws would guide them to live to please God every day. But more than this, God wanted them to understand they were sinners who needed the promised Savior, Jesus.

Using your bookmarks, let's review the Ten Commandments that God gave. *If time, review each commandment and what it means.*
