Review Questions

- 1. What descendants of Esau refused to let the Israelites pass through their land? Edomites.
- 2. God commanded the Israelites not to attack the Moabites or the Ammonites because they were descendants of what relative of Abraham? *His nephew, Lot.*
- 3. What Amorite king over Gilead refused to let the Israelites pass through his land and gathered his people to attack them? Sihon.
- 4. What giant Amorite king attacked the Israelites? He ruled the land of Bashan. Og.
- **5.** How do we know Og was a giant? His bed is described as very large—13.5 feet long and 6 feet wide.
- 6. God gave the Israelites victory over Og, and they settled in his land. Which tribes asked Moses if they could stay in the lands they took from Sihon and Og? Reuben, Gad, and half-tribe of Manasseh.
- 7. What two nations heard about Israel's victories and feared they were next to be conquered? *Moab and Midian*.
- 8. Who was the king of Moab? Balak.
- 9. Who did King Balak want to hire to curse the Israelites? The false prophet Balaam.
- 10. Who stood in the road to block Balaam from going to King Balak? Angel of the Lord.
- **11. Why was the angel blocking Balaam?** Balaam's reasons for going were not right; he wanted wealth and honor from King Balak.
- 12. What stopped Balaam from being killed by the angel of the Lord? His donkey.
- 13. What did Balaam do to his donkey when she was actually saving his life? Hit her with a stick/staff.
- **14.** What miraculous thing did God have the donkey do in response to Balaam's mistreatment? *Speak to Balaam*.
- 15. What stopped Balaam from cursing the Israelites when he was with King Balak? God.
- 16. What false god did the Israelites worship along with their neighbors? Baal.
- 17. Whose idea was it to cause the Israelites to sin and receive punishment from God? Balaam's.
- **18. Who can say the memory verse?** Deuteronomy 7:9. Allow several students to recite the verse.

Bonus: What was the angel of the Lord holding when he stood in the road? Sword.

Bonus: What did Moses tell the Reubenites, Gadites, and half-tribe of Manasseh they would have to do even though they'd received their land? Cross over the Jordan River and help the other tribes fight until they received their land in Canaan.
