What You Heard *In the Word*

- When Ezra returned to Jerusalem, he learned that the Jews had disobeyed God by marrying foreign people.
- When Ezra prayed and reminded the Jewish people of God's law, they were truly sorry for their sin and paid the consequences by sending their wives and children away.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What is a consequence? *When something bad happens because of a poor choice we made.*
2. Why didn't God want the Jews to marry foreign people? *They worshipped false gods and led their husbands and children to do the same.*
3. When the Jews heard Ezra pray about their sins, how did they feel? *They felt sorry for their sins.*
